

Inverclyde Windfarm Fund 2021 Case Study – Greenock Wanderers RFC

Amount Awarded: £1,000.00

"For some time now, our Clubhouse has had a number of leaks coming from the balcony area. Previous attempts to locate and repair these leaks have been unsuccessful and water has continued to ingress our gym and dressing room areas, causing substantial damage to the ceilings.

We engaged a specialist contractor who did a thorough examination of the balcony area and his report concluded that the leaks were coming through the balustrade and the doorways. The total cost of the repairs was placed at £10k.

The Club then made a number of applications for money and fortunately secured a substantial grant from Inverclyde Council together with the very generous award of £1k from the Inverclyde Windfarm Fund.

With the grants received, we were able to find the remainder of the money needed from Club funds to engage the contractor to carry out the work. This happened through the summer and the work is now complete.

Now that the clubhouse is wind and watertight, we are looking to repair the damage to the gym and dressing room areas. Once this is complete, our clubhouse will be returned to its proper state and fully fit for use."
